New Great Yarmouth Corporation as 29 02/1979

CVF29T was new in February 1979 to Great Yarmouth Corporation where it spent its entire working career.

In 1986 when de regulation happened Great Yarmouth Corporation rebranded as Great Yarmouth Transport.

Fast forward to September 1996, First Bus took over operations and First Blue Bus was formed under the umbrella of First Eastern Counties where 29 remained until withdrawn.

In 2003 29 was marked down for scrap with local breakers at Coltishall. But by some miracle it was swapped with a Bedford Coach owned by Mick Peters of Mundesley.

In 2020 we made the approach to acquire the Bristol VR and replaced it with a Volvo Olympian S633MKH ex Fowlers & East Yorkshire Motor Services in September 2020.

CVF29T joined us September 2020. Restoration started in 2021 with a pause until mid 2022. This includes removal of the entire interior including the downstairs floor completely.
